Members held a meet and greet with the two committees.

Presentation by Molalla Arts Commission

The Arts Commission provided an update on the newest mural they are working on which is the logging mural. Parks vice Chair Scott Clarke stated how impressed he was with all the fundraising they had done and applauded them for that.

Presentation by Parks & Recreation Board

Parks Board Vice Chair Scott Clarke provided an update of all the items that the parks board has been working on over the past year and the vision for the upcoming year.

Molalla Arts Commission member Jude Strader asked Mr. Clarke about their feelings of a separate mural group. Mr. Clarke responded that he feels there needs to be two different boards because of the difference of each but did state he hopes to work closely with MAC (Molalla Arts Commission) in order to produce some murals on some of the blank walls that exist in the City of Molalla parks.

Discussion on Loggin Mural and Logging Museum

Mayor Clarke expressed his desire to see a logging museum placed in the City to use all the equipment from nearby logging and provide a tie to Molalla's historic past. Both MAC and members of the Park board agreed that this is a great way to ensure the

history of Molalla is maintained and understood. Both groups agreed that even more could be done using information markers throughout the community. Both groups agreed that the museum would be more of a Parks Board function but should be discussed by both parties in joint meetings at a future date.
